Finale Practice

(Junior, Teen, and Senior teams ONLY)
One (1) hour immediately following their scheduled
Dress Rehearsals (estimated: 7:00- 8:00 PM)

****Any dancers in 3rd grade and below must have a parent present during the entire Dress Rehearsal!****

- Arrive completely dressed and ready and be in dressing rooms by 5:15. Dancers must stay in their dressing room- at all times!
- Volunteers will be in the dressing rooms. They will be in charge of dancers so that parents may enjoy the show. If for some reason your child needs you, EPAC staff will contact you.
 - We ask all EPAC dancers to listen and be respectful to the backstage volunteers. Failure to follow the rules may result in removal from the Recital performance!!
- Video recording is permitted for Dress Rehearsal ONLY. A professional videographer will sell video copies of the Recital to capture your child's special dance!
- No electronics, photography, or videography are allowed in the dressing rooms.
- No food, drinks or GLITTER are allowed in dressing rooms or auditorium.
- Parents of dancers in dancers third grade and younger- you are required to check-in AND out dancers to their assigned dressing rooms during Rehearsal AND Recital.
 - Dancers will only be released to the same parent or representative who checked them in.
 - A female parent/representative must check-in/out dancers from the dressing rooms. NO MALES ALLOWED IN ANY DRESSING ROOMS.
- Bringing something quiet to keep young dancers busy while in the dressing room (nothing that will get on their costume- cards, books, board games, etc.) is highly suggested and encouraged.
- Recreational dancers in 1st-6th grade classes, & Company and Prep teams who have costume changes: EPAC staff and volunteers will be in the dressing rooms to assist your dancers with their costume changes. If you would be more comfortable assisting your dancer, a female parent/representative is welcome to exit the auditorium BETWEEN DANCES to the dressing room.
 - Please do not disrupt the show by exiting the auditorium in the middle of a routine. Wait until the routine has ended to quickly and quietly make your way to the dressing rooms.
 - We would recommend exiting the doors in the center row of the auditorium, to the far left. The door leads to the dressing room hallway.
 - NO MALES ALLOWED IN ANY DRESSING ROOMS.

3 & 4 year old & 3-6 year old Ballet/Tap/Tumble Classes

If you are the parent of a dancer in a 3 & 4 year old OR 3-6 year old Ballet/Tap/Tumble class: dancers MUST sit with a parent in the audience during the **first half of the show during Dress Rehearsal and Recital.**

- At intermission, dancers MUST go potty before immediately walking to their assigned dressing room.
 - There will NOT be an assigned person in their dressing room until intermission.
 - Posted signs will direct dancers to their room.
 - NO MALES ALLOWED IN ANY DRESSING ROOMS.
- A female parent/representative MUST check dancers in before leaving dancers in the dressing rooms.
 - Dancers will only be released to the same parent or representative who checked them in.
 - NO MALES ALLOWED IN ANY DRESSING ROOMS.
- Dancers should arrive to the show in a cover-up over their costume. Please have your dancer dressed and ready to dance while he/she is sitting the audience with you!

Rehearsal Drop-off

- Dancers should meet in their assigned dressing room 15 minutes before rehearsal begins.
 - There will be posted signs directing dancers to their room.
- Parents of dancers in dancers third grade and younger- you are required to check-in dancers to their assigned dressing rooms and stay for the entire rehearsal. Parents can watch Rehearsal in the auditorium (no wristbands required).
 - Dancers will only be released to the same parent or representative who checked them in.
 - A female parent/representative must check-in/out dancer's from the dressing rooms. NO MALES ALLOWED IN ANY DRESSING ROOMS OR DRESSING ROOM HALLWAYS.
- Arrive in first costume with hair and make-up fixed (stage ready!).
 - We ask all performing dancers to wear full hair and make-up to Rehearsal.
 - Please wear a cover up over costumes. We encourage dancers to wear their Extreme 2022 Recital shirts!
 - Ensure all costumes and accessories are clearly labeled with dancer's FIRST and LAST name. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Finale

Extreme dancers of all ages, grades, classes and teams participate in our Finale!

- Students will keep on their last costume for the Finale.
- 3-6 year-old dancers will be assigned a "BIG SISTER" during Dress Rehearsal who will dance with them during finale. These big sisters will be responsible for their assigned little one and will walk them back to their assigned dressing room immediately following the show.
- **Junior, Teen, and Senior teams ONLY** will have a finale practice for one (1) hour immediately following their scheduled Dress Rehearsals (estimated: 7- 8 PM)
 - Dancers are to keep on their Finale leggings/Recital shirt for Finale practice.
 - This is a drop-off practice and will be closed to parents- thank you for understanding.
 - Please note: we cannot provide you with an exact end-time! Although Dress Rehearsals are scheduled to end at 7, some Rehearsals may end early/late depending on how the Rehearsal goes. This, of course, impacts the start/end time of Finale practice as it will immediately follow Rehearsals. We greatly appreciate your patience, understanding, and cooperation!

Rehearsal & Recital Pickup

A female parent/representative may pick up you dancer in their assigned dressing room after both Dress Rehearsal, and Recital.

- Parents of dancers in dancers third grade and younger- you are required to check-out dancers from their assigned dressing rooms.
 - Dancers will only be released to the same parent or representative who checked them in.
 - A female parent/representative must check-in/out dancers from the dressing rooms. **NO MALES ALLOWED IN ANY DRESSING ROOMS.**
- Check for EVERY costume piece before leaving rehearsal. Things are hectic backstage! We want to be sure all dancers have all of their pieces for the big show. There are no extra costume pieces and lost items cannot be replaced.

Make-Up & Hair

- Nails: Dancers should NOT have colored nail polish on! Clear nail polish ONLY.
- Makeup: ALL dancers should wear bright, color stay red lipstick and heavy blush.
 - Make-up should be heavier than normal- stage lights tend to wash faces out.
 - Stick to a natural color palette for eyeshadows (browns, tans, golds).
 - The amount of additional make-up on little ones is completely up to parents.
- Hair: All hair pieces should be secured with several bobby pins!
 - Dancers in Recreational 3-6 year old classes: half-up, half down
 - Dancers in Recreational 1st-3rd grade, 4th-6th grade, 7th-12th grade classes: slick back, high ponytail
 - Company and Prep dancers: contest hair (guidelines on Company and Prep Parent Bulletin Board)

Costumes

- All costumes, accessories and shoes should be clearly labeled with dancer's first and last name.
- Tights & Earrings: ALL dancers are REQUIRED to wear tights under their costume and earrings.
 - Recreational dancers: tights and earrings are included in the Spring Recital fee. Pick-up your dancer's tights, earrings, and Recital shirt on Friday, April 12th from 4:00-6:30 PM.
 - Company & Prep dancers: Tights and earrings are available for purchase at the front desk.
 - Deadline to order tights that will arrive in time for Recital is May 9th.
(deadline to purchase tights for Picture Week is March 28th).
- Shoes: see chart below. Extreme carries a limited stock of Jazz, Ballet, and Turning Pointe shoes. Please see the front desk for more information.

Dancers

- Dancers are to be in their assigned dressing room 30 minutes before show time completely dressed and ready!
 - Dancer's in third grade and younger must have a female parent/representative check them in/out. NO MALES ALLOWED IN ANY DRESSING ROOMS.
- Arrive in first costume with hair and make-up fixed (stage ready!).
 - Please wear a cover up over costumes. We encourage dancers to wear their Extreme 2024 Recital shirts!
 - Ensure all costumes and accessories are clearly labeled with dancer's FIRST and LAST name. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Follow the same rules (check-in/check-out, dressing room locations, etc.) for Recital as Dress Rehearsal and the show will be a huge success!

Audience Members & Parents

- Doors will not open until 30 minutes before each showtime.
- No RECORDING or TAKING PICTURES during the show.
- Seats are first come, first serve! Audience members will not be permitted to save seats for the show.
- Parking can get a little hectic. Please try to be patient- everyone is here for the same reason. We want to make sure that everyone can navigate in and out of the show safely.

Wristbands

- Be sure to have your wristbands! Entry to the show will not be permitted without a wristband.
- Wristbands are available for pre-purchase for \$7 until April 26th.
 - Wristbands can be purchased through your Parent Portal- through the Online Store.
 - Checkout process must be completed to receive wristbands. Failure to complete the checkout process will result in the system REMOVING the wristbands from your account and account balance- you will have to purchase wristbands at the door.
 - If selecting the cash/check option, the front desk must receive payment by April 26th. Failure to submit payment by the deadline will result in the system REMOVING the wristbands from your account and account balance- you will have to purchase wristbands at the door.
 - Pre-purchased wristbands must be picked up from the front desk the week of May 13th.
- Wristbands will be sold on show day, at the door for \$10, cash only, EXACT CHANGE APPRECIATED!
- Extreme dancers wearing their Spring Recital 2024 shirts do not need a wristband to enter. This includes Extreme dancers who are watching siblings in other shows.
- Children aged 3 and under do not require a wristband for entry.

Recital Music

Recreational dancers: Your dancer's Recital music can be purchased through your Parent Portal for \$5. You will receive the music in an email on Friday evening.

Company & Prep dancers: Recital music has been uploaded to your Parent Portal- access the music through your Class Documents.

Extreme will NOT send videos of the dances! Parents are responsible for coming into class the last 10 minutes during Open Window Week to video the dance. We encourage Extreme parents to exchange numbers with another parent in your dancer's class so they can send you a video of the dance if you are unable to come for Open Window Week.

Flowers, Teddy Bears, Trophies & Crowns

Flower bouquets, teddy bears and trophies and crowns/tiaras are available for pre-order to surprise your dancer with on their big, special day!

There will also be a small number of extras to purchase the day of the show, but pre-ordering is highly recommended!

Flower, teddy bears, and trophy/crown can be pre-ordered through your Parent Portal- through the Online Store.

Order deadline is April 29th.

Video Forms

A professional videographer will video your dancer's memorable performance at the Spring Recital.

Recital Programs

Recital Programs are a fun keepsake that will include every dancer's name and class. Program advertisements can be purchased for your dancer or business. Ads can include pictures and some sweet words for your dancer to cherish forever!

In addition to having your dancer's personal or business ad printed in our Recital program, you have the opportunity to display your ad on our drop-down projection screen in the auditorium prior to the start of the show. Slideshow ads will be displayed on a running loop for 30 minutes, for all 3 shows, while spectators are entering the auditorium before the show.
